
ILLINOIS REGION 3 PROTOCOLS

AMBULANCE SUPPLIES - BLS**General Equipment**

- (1) Ambulance to hospital radio (Merci – tests functional)
- (1) Wheeled multi-level cot with 3 sets of straps
- (1) Three point fastener for cot/cot fits securely
- (1) Secondary stretcher with 3 sets of straps
- (10) Illinois PCR run sheets
- (1 Each) Blood pressure cuff with gauge (infant, child, adult, obese)
- (2) Stethoscope
- (1) Bandage shears
- (1) Child/infant car seat
- (1) Pediatric sizing/dosing chart or tape
- (1) Poison control number (posted)
- (1) Pediatric trauma score reference (On Illinois PCR run sheets)
- (1) OB kit, sterile
- (1) Aluminum foil or (1) silver swaddler with head cover
- (2) Pillows with pillowcases
- (2) Sheets
- (2) Blankets
- (2) Emesis basins/vomit bags
- (3) Cold packs
- (2) Disposable Styrofoam or plastic drinking cups
- (1 Each) Urinal and bedpan
- (1 quart) Drinking water (sterile water is ok)
- (1) Plastic baby bottle with nipple
- (2) Penlights
- (1) Glucometer with strips (optional)
- (10) SMART Triage Tag
- (1) *AED with combo pads – razor/towels/wash cloths (optional)*
- (1) *RAZOR (to be included with AED)*

Personal Safety/Biohazard Equipment

- (Appropriate Sizes) Nonporous disposable gloves
- (1) Red biohazard bag – impermeable
- (2) Goggles or face shields
- (2) Face masks to cover nose and mouth
- (2) N-95 masks
- (2) Gowns

Dressing/Bandaging Supplies

- (6) Trauma dressing
- (20) 4" X 4" gauze pads
- (10) Roller style self adhering bandages (4" X 5yd)
- (2) Vaseline gauze 3" X 8"
- (2) Burn sheet (clean, individually wrapped)
- (2) Adhesive tape rolls

AMBULANCE SUPPLIES – BLS (CONTINUED)**Medications**

- Adult Epi-pen 0.3 mg
- Pediatric Epi-pen 0.15 mg (60 lbs or less)
- Oral Glucose*

Oxygenation/Airway Equipment

- (1) On board Oxygen tank – not empty
- (1) Portable O₂ tank with 15 LPM regulator – at least “D” size/not empty
- (1) Spare portable tank full (secured)
- (2) Oxygen connection tubing
- (3 Each) Nasal cannulas (adult, child and infant)
- (2 Each) Non-rebreather masks (adult, child and infant)
- (1) CPR mask with one way valve
- (1) Adult bag-valve-mask (adult and child size masks)
- (1) Pediatric bag-valve-mask (child and infant size masks)
- (1 Set) Oral airways (infant through adult)
- (1 Each) Nasopharyngeal airways (infant, child, adult – sizes 12-30F)
- (1) Lubricant for airway equipment (Surgilube, K-Y, etc.)
- (1) On board suction equipment
 1. tests as functional, 10 ft. clear ¼ inside diameter tubing, collection bottle
 2. obtains 300 mm within 4 seconds of clamping tube
 3. adjustable vacuum levels
 4. collection bottle holds 1000 ml
- (1) Portable suction (tests as functional with clear tubing, ¼ inch inside diameter, collection bottle, can run on battery for 20 minutes if necessary) manually operated suction device (IDPH approved)
- (6) Semi-rigid pharyngeal suction tips (Yankauer style)
- (6 Each) Sterile suction catheters (6-8F, 10-12F, 14-18F)
- (2000 ml) Sterile solution (water or saline, bottles or bags)
- Combitube (optional)*

Immobilization/Splinting

- (1) Long spine board with 3 sets of straps and cervical immobilization device
- (1) Pediatric spine board with 3 sets of straps (optional)
- (1) Short spine board or vest type device (KED, ZED)
- (1 Each) Rigid cervical collars (pediatric, small, medium, large)
- (1 Set) Extremity splints – adult (two each, long and short)
- (1 Set) Extremity splints – pediatric (two each, long and short)
- (1 Set) Restraints for arms and legs
- (5) Triangular bandages with safety pins
- (1 Each) Traction splint (pediatric and adult)
- (1) Scoop stretcher
- (1 Each) Pneumatic anti-shock garment/MAST (adult and pediatric) (Optional)

AMBULANCE SUPPLIES – BLS (CONTINUED)

Extrication Equipment

- (1) Wrecking bar – at least 24 inches
- (2) Fire extinguishers – at least 5 lb. ABC each
- (1) Flashlight (battery operated)
- Agreement with local fire department/rescue agency for extrication
- Agreement with local garage to replace/repair tires

General Observation

- Patient area is clean.
- Equipment is secured in patient area.
