CLASS	Diuretic
ACTION	A potent loop diuretic that inhibits sodium and chloride
	reabsorption at the proximal and distal tubules and ascending loop
	of Henle in the kidney to promote prompt diuresis.
INDICATIONS	<ul> <li>Congestive heart failure (CHF)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>CHF with pulmonary edema</li> </ul>
CONTRAINDICATIONS	<ul><li>Dehydration</li></ul>
	<ul><li>Hypotension</li></ul>
	<ul><li>Hypokalemia</li></ul>
	<ul><li>Pregnancy</li></ul>
	<ul> <li>Anuria (inability to produce urine)</li> </ul>
