PROMETHAZINE (PHENERGAN)	
CLASS	Phenothiazine Antihistamine
ACTION	Inhibits the chemoreceptor trigger zone in the medulla to produce anti-emetic effect. Blocks H1 and H2 histamine receptor sites.
INDICATIONS	Vomiting
CONTRAINDICATIONS	Acute asthma attack
PRECAUTIONS	<ul> <li>Extravasation (infiltration) can cause necrosis, tissue sloughing, gangrene</li> <li>Should be diluted in at least 10 mL Normal Saline</li> <li>Should be administered very slowly over several minutes</li> <li>Patient should be instructed to advise you if any pain or burning with administration</li> </ul>
SIDE EFFECTS	<ul> <li>Drowsiness; excess sedation; confusion</li> <li>Hypotension</li> <li>Dizziness</li> <li>Palpitations</li> </ul>
ROUTE	IV
DOSE	12.5 mg diluted in 10 mL Normal Saline slow IVP. May repeat X 1 if necessary for a maximum dose of 25 mg.
PEDIATRIC DOSE	<ul> <li>Child over age 2 = 0.25 - 0.5 mg/kg with maximum dose of 25 mg</li> <li>Not for administration in patients under the age of two years.</li> <li>Dilute in 10 mL normal saline and administer very slowly over several minutes</li> <li>Utilize Broselow tape or pediatric weight based dosing chart to confirm dose</li> </ul>
ONSET	3 to 5 minutes
DURATION	6 to 12 hours
STOCK	(2) 25 mg inj.
