INDICATIONS	<ul> <li>To increase peripheral vascular resistance in CPR (as an alternative to epinephrine or after epinephrine has been used)</li> </ul>
CONTRAINDICATIONS	<ul> <li>None in the emergency setting</li> </ul>
PRECAUTIONS	<ul><li>Few in the emergency setting</li></ul>
SIDE EFFECTS	<ul> <li>Infrequent with low dose</li> </ul>
ROUTE	• IV
DOSE (ADULT)	<ul> <li>Cardiac arrest: 40 units IV (single dose only)</li> </ul>
PEDIATRIC DOSE	<ul> <li>Not indicated</li> </ul>
